



Obituary – Mrs. Effie Miller May 31, 1920 – March 4, 2012

RECIPE

Hummingbird Bundt Cake

By Bobby Creed

CAKE BATTER

- 1 ½ cups chopped pecans
- 3 cups all-purpose flour
- 2 cups sugar
- 1 tsp. baking soda
- 1 tsp. ground cinnamon
- ½ tsp. salt
- 3 large eggs, lightly beaten
- 1 ¾ cups mashed ripe bananas (about 4 large)
- 1 (8-oz.) can crushed pineapple (do not drain)
- ¾ cup canola oil
- 1 ½ tsp. vanilla extract



GLAZE

- 4 oz. cream cheese cubed and softened
- 2 cups sifted powdered sugar
- 1 tsp. vanilla extract
- 1 to 2 Tbsp. milk

1. **Prepare Cake Batter:** Preheat oven to 350. Bake pecans in a single layer in a shallow pan 8 to 10 minutes or until toasted and fragrant, stirring halfway through.
2. Stir together flour and next 4 ingredients in a large bowl; stir in eggs and next 4 ingredients, stirring just until dry ingredients are moistened. Sprinkle 1 cup toasted pecans into a greased and floured 14-cup Bundt pan. Spoon batter over pecans.
3. Bake at 350 for 1 hour to 1 hour and 10 minutes or until a long wooden pick inserted in center comes out clean. Cool cake in pan on a wire rack 15 minutes; remove from pan to wire rack, and cool completely (about 2 hours).
4. **Prepare Glaze:** Process cream cheese, powdered sugar, vanilla, and 1 Tbsp. milk in a food processor until well blended. Add remaining 1 Tbsp. milk, 1 tsp. at a time, processing until smooth. Immediately pour glaze over cooled cake, and sprinkle with remaining ½ cup toasted pecans.


